## Hiking on Lamma Island

*Spend a Sunday afternoon walking leisurely from Yung Shue Wan to Sok Kwu Wan and enjoy the beautiful scenery and serenity*

At Yung Shue Wan, lots of expatriates open specialty shops which display the fusion of Eastern and Western cultures. Stroll through the villages passing Hung Shing Ye Beach, then walk uphill and see the dumbbell shape Cheung Chau at the top of the hill. Continue walking about 20 minutes, seeing Lo So Shing (蘆鬚城), Shen Feng Cave (神風洞) and the 200 year-old Tin Hau Temple before reaching Sok Kwu Wan. Our tour ends at here with a famous seafood dinner. Meet at Pier No. 4 for Lamma Island at Central (outside IFC) on **12 November 2006 (Sunday)** at **1510 hours** (ferry leaves at 1530 hours sharp to Yung Shue Wan boarding from 1520 hours). The cruise is about 35 minutes. From Yung Shue Wan, walk for about 1 hour 30 minutes and have a seafood dinner. The Alumni will pay the ferry fare for all members. Cost for dinner is estimated at around \$200 per person (depending on the food we order on pro rata basis). Participants should consider his/her health/physical conditions before taking part in it and buy his/her own insurance for this outing; MPAAA is not responsible for any injuries arising out from it. But the walk is not demanding at all.
