The Psychological Services Unit (PSU), established in 1988, stems from a tested model linking service with training and is the first of its kind in Hong Kong. The PSU is a training clinic that provides comprehensive clinical and educational psychology services to the general public. Our services include psychoeducational assessment for children with learning difficulties, emotional and behavioural difficulties, intellectual assessment, training for children and consultation for parents. We also offer assessment and treatment for adults with psychological health issues. Services at the PSU are provided mainly by psychologists-in-training in our MSocSc in Clinical Psychology and Educational Psychology programmes, under the direct supervision of our teaching staff.
