

The creation of this book has been under the close monitor of the Steering Committee who has been meeting frequently since 1999. The Development & Alumni Affairs Office in the University undertakes the execution. A Research Team, from the University's Policy 21 Ltd, collected data through various channels, including extensive interviewing, and produced two initial drafts of the chapters. The Executive Editor then re-organised the contents until distinct themes unfold. Meanwhile, the team in the Development & Alumni Affairs Office worked on data verification, further research and revisions, photo collation, design and proof-reading. An extensive photo archive was established in due course. The chapters were read and scrutinised by respective graduate groups. The Convocation Standing Committee also provided input. The Executive Editor then worked out several revisions of the draft. The final draft was modified by various writers before it went to the Hong Kong University Press. What appears now before the reader is the result of hard work by many parties.

The not insignificant efforts channelled into this project for data collection and data verification are, however, never adequate to do justice to the impact that the 90,000 HKU alumni on the whole have brought to the developments of Hong Kong. To complement this monograph, a web-extension of this volume has been established in order to further reflect the many facets and profiles of the University's graduates in various fields. Editor's Notes

1. *For the format of names, Christian name (if any) goes first, then surname, followed by given name which is hyphenated except for Chinese pinyin.*
2. *For HKU graduates, their Chinese names, degrees obtained and years of graduation appear after the graduates' names only when they are mentioned for the first time in that chapter or in the table of a list.*
3. *For alumni who left the university during the War before their graduation, no degree but their year(s) of study in HKU appears. Apart from some leading figures better known in Chinese, Chinese names of personalities other than HKU graduates are generally not mentioned.*
4. *Only degrees obtained in HKU are shown after the graduates' names.*
5. *Addressing titles, e.g. Sir, Professor, Dr, Mr, Mrs, of people are not included.*
6. *Honorary titles, e.g. MBE, GBM, JP are not included.*
7. *Where the person has a better-known alias different from the name he/she registered with the University, the alias is included in parenthesis.*
8. *The cut-off date for information was July 31, 2002.*
