The first-ever HKU global alumni convention was held in Shanghai, China from November 2nd to 4th, 2006. More than 600 delegates attended. The theme was "Discover Shanghai. Discover China – Tomorrow Today". It provided a platform for delegates to gain insights into the future of China

on the world stage and to determine the role of HKU alumni during the critical times of change. It was also a good opportunity for networking and re-union.

Mentorship Program

Our association has been a supporter of HKU Mentorship Programme. Incorporating the value of relationship building and interpersonal communications, it aims to provide a transformative and holistic development of the students. This year, we have paired up fifteen mentors and sixteen mentees.
