NOTICE is hereby given that the Annual General Meeting of the Hong Kong University Alumni Association of Ontario will be held on Sunday, the 18th day of March, 2007 at 5:30 p.m. at Diamond Banquet Hall (First Markham Place), with the following business to be transacted:-

- 1. To receive and consider the Annual Report 2006 -2007;
- 2. To receive and consider the Treasurer's Report;
- 3. To elect directors and members of the Executive Committee of the Association for the year 2006/2007;
- 4. To adopt the following amendments to the By-laws of the Association:

Sub-clauses 2(a)(i) and (ii) and 2(b) of the Association's By-Laws be deleted in their entirety and be replaced by the following:

"(2) (a) There shall be three categories of members in the Association, namely regular members, life members and honourary or affiliated members. The eligibility of each category is specified as follows: (i) a regular member of the Association shall be a former student or staff member of the University of Hong Kong;

(ii) a life member of the Association shall be a former student or staff member of the University of Hong Kong; and

(iii) an honourary or affiliated member shall be an individual who may not be eligible for the foregoing two categories of membership, but has demonstrated an active interest in promoting the objectives of the Association, and was appointed an honourary or affiliated member of the Association at a general meeting of the members.

(b) There shall be an annual membership fee and a life membership fee for the regular member and the life member respectively in such amount as determined by the Executive Committee from time to time." and

5. To transact any other business.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that any regular member in good standing shall be entitled to nominate another regular member in good standing to the Executive Committee and to be elected to the Executive Committee and to cast vote. Any such nomination should be emailed to the Association at:
