The Hong Kong University Alumni Association of Ontario has been a sponsor of the debate competition for 15 years.

The 18th annual Ontario Chinese Debate Competition was hosted by Ontario Inter-Collegiate Chinese Debate Alliance. Every year, the executive board is formed with students from various universities in Ontario. Participating schools include University of Toronto, University of Waterloo, Wilfred Laurier University, York University, Ryerson University, McMaster University and University of Western Ontario. This year, 200 debaters, a total of 26 teams from 7 universities joined the competition. On March 1, 2009 the final was held at First Markham Place. Two of our members, Charles Law and Augustine Chan were there serving as adjudicators. This year's Champion team was from U of Toronto. First runner up went to York University, and Ryerson University, second runner up.
